GasLog Partners LP Announces Public Offering of Common Units

MONACO, August 1, 2016 -- GasLog Partners LP (the "Partnership" or "we") (NYSE: GLOP) today announced a public offering of 2,750,000 common units. The Partnership intends to grant the underwriter a 30-day option to purchase up to 412,500 additional common units from the Partnership.

The Partnership plans to use the net proceeds from the public offering for general partnership purposes, which may include future acquisitions, debt repayment, capital expenditures and additions to working capital. We currently expect that this will include future acquisitions from GasLog Ltd., our parent ("GasLog").

Barclays Capital Inc. is acting as underwriter for the offering.

The offering is being made only by means of a prospectus. A copy of the preliminary prospectus relating to the offering may be obtained from Barclays Capital Inc. c/o Broadridge Financial Solution 1155 Long Island Avenue, Edgewood NY 11717, Telephone: (888) 603-5847.

A registration statement relating to these securities was declared effective by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission on June 8, 2015. About the Partnership

The Partnership is a growth-oriented master limited partnership focused on owning, operating and acquiring LNG carriers under long-term charters. The Partnership's fleet consists of eight LNG carriers with an average carrying capacity of 148,750 cbm, each of which has a multi-year time charter. The Partnership's executive offices are located at Gildo Pastor Center, 7 Rue du Gabian, MC 98000, Monaco.
