## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Registration Statement on Form S-8 (the "Registration Statement") is filed by REGENXBIO Inc. (the "Company") for the purpose of registering additional shares of its common stock, \$0.0001 par value per share (the "Common Stock"), under the Company's 2015 Equity Incentive Plan (the "Plan").

The number of shares of Common Stock available for issuance under the Plan is subject to an automatic annual increase as of the first business day of the Company's fiscal year equal to the lower of (a) 4.0% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding on December 31 of the prior year or (b) a number of shares of Common Stock determined by the Company's Board of Directors (the "Evergreen Provision"). Accordingly, the number of shares of Common Stock available for issuance under the Plan was increased by 1,251,810 shares effective January 2, 2018. This Registration Statement registers the 1,251,810 additional shares of Common Stock available for issuance under the Plan as a result of the Evergreen Provision.

Of the 6,315,513 shares of Common Stock currently authorized by the Plan, (a) 2,952,100 shares of Common Stock were registered pursuant to the Company's Registration Statement on Form S-8 filed on September 17, 2015 (Commission File No. 333-206984), (b) 1,052,538 shares of Common Stock were registered pursuant to the Company's Registration Statement on Form S-8 filed on March 3, 2016 (Commission File No. 333-209899) and (c) 1,059,065 shares of Common Stock were registered pursuant to the Company's Registration Statement on Form S-8 filed on March 7, 2017 (Commission File No. 333-216508) (collectively, the "Original Registration Statements"). Pursuant to General Instruction E to Form S-8 under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, the contents of the Original Registration Statements, including any amendments thereto or filings incorporated therein by reference are incorporated herein by reference and made part of this Registration Statement. Any items in the Original Registration Statements not expressly changed hereby shall be as set forth in the Original Registration Statements.
